

FILCOM CIRCULAR No. 09-2016

SUBJECT : COMELEC's Office for Overseas Voting (OFOV) Guidelines 2016-

001 - "In the matter of allowing registered overseas voter to vote

in Posts where he/she is currently residing".

Further to Embassy's Filcom Circular Nos.07 and 08 2016, Post wishes to inform the Filipino Communities in India and Nepal of COMELEC's Office for Overseas Voting (OFOV) Guidelines 2016-001 "In the matter of allowing registered overseas voter to vote in Posts where he/she is currently residing".

In the aforesaid OFOV Guidelines, all registered overseas voters with active registration status in any Post, may now be allowed to vote in the Embassy/Consulate/Post near their current places of residence or work provided that said active Overseas Voter's will manifest their intention to vote in writing before the Embassy/Consulate/Post concerned.

Attached, for reference is a copy of the Manifestation of Intent to vote.
