FILCOM CIRCULAR No. 09-2016

SUBJECT : COMELEC's Office for Overseas Voting (OFOV) Guidelines 2016-001 - *"In the matter of allowing registered overseas voter to vote in Posts where he/she is currently residing"*.

Further to Embassy's Filcom Circular Nos.07 and 08 2016, Post wishes to inform the Filipino Communities in India and Nepal of COMELEC's Office for Overseas Voting (OFOV) Guidelines 2016-001 *"In the matter of allowing registered overseas voter to vote in Posts where he/she is currently residing"*.

In the aforesaid OFOV Guidelines, all registered overseas voters with active registration status in any Post, may now be allowed to vote in the Embassy/Consulate/Post near their current places of residence or work provided that said active Overseas Voter's will manifest their intention to vote in writing before the Embassy/Consulate/Post concerned.

Attached, for reference is a copy of the Manifestation of Intent to vote.
